SCOPE IN UGANDA

-  Farm mechanization in Uganda is still in its early stages most farmers relying on manual labor or basic tools. This creates a significant opportunity for tractors, harvesters, and advanced farm equipment to improve productivity and efficiency
-  The market highly favour affordable and compact farm equipment, as the majority of farmers are small and medium-scale. Demand is growing for mini tractors, multi-purpose implements
-  Irrigation infrastructure remains underdeveloped, with crop production heavily dependent on rainfall. This opens strong potential for drip irrigation, sprinkler systems
-  Fertilizer usage in Uganda is relatively low compared to global standards, but awareness is steadily increasing
-  The government is actively promoting modern farming practices and agricultural development. Initiatives supporting mechanization, irrigation, and improved inputs are creating a favorable environment for international suppliers and technology providers
